

Little Hidden Gems ...

hose little hidden gems can be found just about everywhere in this big country of ours, whether you are a seasoned traveler or just starting out. You just need to take that road less traveled, check out that little dot on the map or find it on the Internet. It's out there... just waiting for you.

The Wells Fargo Museum in uptown Charlotte, North Carolina

was just such a place for us. We didn't know that they even had museums, with Charlotte just being one of them. We opted for the free, self-guided tour although you can take a guided tour with reservations.

The museum highlights the colorful history of Wells Fargo and Company including the origin of Wachovia Bank and the gold mining era in North

Carolina. The main attraction for the museum is the rare Concord stagecoach built in the mid-19th century. Being a hands-on museum, step into a replica of the stagecoach and step back into time. Other exhibits include a 1960s simulated drive-up teller. a working telegraph and an 1889 reproduction of a Wachovia Bank branch, gold nuggets, rare coins and paper money. A small gift shop offers Wells Fargo related gifts. Open Tues.-Sat./9 to 5. More information wfmuseum. cit@wellsfargo.com

Did you ever wonder where the cranberry got its name? Did you know that the cranberry is one of only three fruits native to North America? Did vou know that there are more than 1.000 cranberry products on today's market? And did you know that two-thirds of the 500-million pounds of cranberries that Americans consume is produced in Wisconsin? The answers to these questions can be found at the Cranberry Discovery Center located at the historic Union Cranberry Warehouse in Warrens, Wisconsin,

Upstairs the gift shop/store





offers samples of the many different flavors of cranberries, reasonable prices on cranberry treats, gift items and souvenirs plus an ice cream parlor.

The lower level of the Center features a free museum, which takes you back into the history of the cranberry. There are many exhibits, work areas, equipment and a short film about the industry. We learned that the man-made and natural wetlands of the cranberry marshes are abundant with many kinds of wildlife and birds and can even provide some good fishing. Also that the marshes are flooded three times a year. First in the spring to protect from the cold temperatures and some insects. In the fall for harvest and lastly in the winter to form a thick layer of ice to protect the vines from the frigid Wisconsin winters.

Did you know that cranberry blossoms need to be pollinated to produce fruit and that honeybees will travel 1 to 2 miles from their

hives to gather nectar? Or that on a good day, a worker bee will pollinate more than 2,000 cranberry blossoms? Lots of questions and answers but a very educational visit on our part.

movie called RV, starring Robin Williams, was released in theaters. More than likely, most of you have seen it and if so, you will remember the 1948 red and white Flxible bus that the family rented for a cross country road trip. These old Flxible buses are a real American treasure and the one used in the movie is the prize exhibit at Jack Sisemore Traveland RV Museum found in Amarillo, Texas.







This 6,000 square-foot building houses a most unusual and unique array of RVs, many in the same condition they were found and some restored. The world's oldest, 1935 Torpedo Airstream makes its home here along with a 1918 Harley Davidson motorcycle and a 1930s gas station. Exhibits rotate frequently.

This free museum was opened in 1988 for the purpose of "sharing with the people". For more information www.rvmuseum.net

Orange Pineapple Cake

This orange pineapple cake, also called pig pickin' cake, is one of my very favorite desserts! Topped with a delicious and fluffy whipped pineapple vanilla pudding frosting. So moist, light and refreshing.

Ingredients:

- 1 box of Supreme Orange Cake Mix
- 1 box Instant Coconut Pudding Mix
- 1 Cup of Wesson Oil
- 3 Large Eggs
- 1 can Diet Mt. Dew

Frosting Ingredients:

1 20 oz. can of crushed pineapple 1 package (3.4 oz) Instant Vanilla Pudding Mix 12 oz. Cool Whip, thawed Pineapple slices (optional) 1 cup Coconut (optional)

Directions for the Cake:

Preheat oven to 350°. In mixing bowl add the first 5 ingredients. Spray pans and then pour into 3 - 9" pans. Cook for 25-30 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Remove from oven and cool completely.

For Frosting:

Combine the crushed pineapple with pudding mix until completely mixed. Fold in the Cool Whip. Add coconut, if desired. Spread over cooled cake. Can garnish with pineapple slices if desired. Refrigerate for at least an hour. ENJOY.

Exploring Fort Davis

t was established on the eastern side of the Davis Mountains, in a box canyon near the Limpia Creek. Wood, water and grass were plentiful and it consisted of primitive wooden structures. It was regarded as one of the most pleasant post in the West. The officers and enlisted men maintained a respectable spirit and they left a proud record of accomplishments.

Fort Davis, strategically located,

is one of the best surviving examples of an Indian Wars military post, in the defense system of western Texas from 1854 to 1891. Troops were stationed at the post to protect emigrants, freight wagons, mail coaches and travelers who hoped to reach the gold fields of California while traveling on the Trans-Pecos portion of the San Antonio-El Paso Road and the Chihuahua Trail.

Fort Davis, at an elevation of 4,900 feet and covering 523 acres, became a national historic site in 1963 and through the efforts of the National Park Service, a continuing program of restoration and preservation have managed to save many of the original structures although some of the foundations and ruins remain fragile.

The visitor center, which is located in what was originally







the enlisted men's barracks, should be your first stop. Next door is a museum and auditorium which offers an orientation video. From there, you can tour the historic site on your own and at your leisure. Allow one to two hours.

In the past, Fort Davis's primary role was safeguarding the west Texas frontier and today the role is to strive to make their facilities accessible to all and helping to preserve Fort Davis for future generations....
