Colorado National Monument

The Colorado Monument is a special place: not a man-made tribute, but a dramatic example of the incomparable artistry of nature. The park embraces some of the same geologic wonders as Bryce Canyon, the Arches and the Grand Canyon National Parks. The only paved road through the park is the 23-mile Rim Rock Drive, built by the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) and many local men in those depression-wracked days.

It will take you from the Grand Valley floor up onto the brilliantly eroded Uncompahgre Plateau, dipping in and out of canyons along the way and will provide views of the 20,533-acre park. Here broad forested mesas, deep colorful sheer canyons and towering sandstone monoliths celebrate a billion and a half years of history.

Cold Shivers Point, Red Canyon, Coke Ovens and Artists Point are a few of the intriguing

names of the overlooks. Stop for a moment and take in the breathtaking view of the dramatic landforms. One of our favorites and best known formation is the 450-foot high Independence Monument, created by the forces of wind, weather and erosion.

Due to the efforts of John Otto, Trailbuilder, Promoter and Patriot and sometimes referred to as the “Hermit of the Monument Canyon”, the Colorado National Monument came into being on



May 24th, 1911 when President William H. Taft signed proclamation No. 1126 making it Colorado's second national monument.

Set aside to protect its "extraordinary examples of weathering and erosion," the Colorado National Monument encompasses a 32-square mile area of spectacular scenery. As many as 730,000 visitors enjoy the beauty of sheer sandstone cliffs, towering monoliths, and panoramic canyon views annually.

The monument has a visitor center, a campground and a dozen hiking trails and is a mecca for bicyclists and rock climbers.

Egg & Sausage Breakfast Roll-Ups

This recipe is a fun take on your typical breakfast sandwich. Corn flour tortillas are filled with sausage links, scrambled eggs, and cheddar cheese, before being rolled up and toasted in a hot pan. I used pork sausage links in these yummy Egg and Sausage Breakfast Taquitos and my family devoured them. They're so incredibly easy too.

INGREDIENTS:

- 7 ounce box fully cooked sausage links
- 5 large eggs
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 ½ cups shredded cheese, your favorite kind
- 1 cup baby spinach leaves, chopped (optional)
- 10 white corn tortillas, or 6" flour tortillas

DIRECTIONS:

- Preheat oven to 425 degrees F.
- Add frozen sausage links to a large skillet over medium-high heat. Cook, turning occasionally, until warmed through.
- Remove to a plate, leaving a little bit of the sausage grease in the pan.
- Crack eggs into a bowl and add a splash of milk. Whisk well with a fork and add to the pan.
- Season with salt/pepper. Cook for a few minutes, tossing and scrambling as they cook. (If using spinach, add it to the pan about 2 minutes before the eggs are done cooking.) Remove from heat.
- Warm the tortillas on a hot skillet or griddle for a few seconds until they are pliable.
- Place sausage link on top, then sprinkle with shredded cheese. Roll up and place, seam side down, on a baking sheet lined with foil or parchment paper.
- Spray lightly with cooking spray and bake for 10-15 minutes





Trailbuilder Promoter & Patriot

"I came here last year and found these canyons and they felt like the heart of the world to me. I'm going to stay and promote this place, because it should be a national park"...John Otto 1907

John Otto was born in Marthasville, Missouri on December 30th, 1870. In 1906, he made his way to the Grand Valley to work as a "powder monkey"...someone who works with explosives on a water pipeline. He acquainted himself with the neighboring topography and fell in love with the sheer-walled canyons cut deep into the sandstone and granite-gneiss/schist rock formations. For twenty years, Otto, usually seen with his two burros, Foeie and Cookie, lived alone in the canyons and used a pick and shovel to carve out the first trails into this rugged landscape to reach the glorious red rock canyons. Always the patriot, he named the rock formations he encountered after great heroes and historic events. Some of the formations, such as Independence Monument and Liberty Cap, still bear the names he gave them.

Known as eccentric and a recluse, he put aside his solitude to publicize these beautiful canyons. Beginning in 1909, he conducted tours, spoke to reporters, wrote newspaper editorials, held

fundraisers, had petitions signed and wrote many letters to Washington politicians. His enthusiasm was contagious and others joined the band wagon.

The year 1911 held many events for John Otto. On May 24, President William H. Taft established Colorado National Monument with presidential proclamation No. 1126, under the authority of the Antiquities Act. This became the second national monument established in the state of Colorado and the 17th national monument unit. (The first national monument was Wheeler Geologic Area, near Creede, which held the title from 1908 until 1950, when it became part of Colorado's protected La Garita Wilderness Area.)

On June 20th, John Otto and Beatrice Farham were married. Beatrice was a 20th-century Boston artist and entrepreneur who was notable for her native-American-inspired fashion and handicrafts. The marriage was short-lived when Beatrice left a few months later and never returned.


On July 4th, John Otto launched a unique tradition honored by the park and community yet today...by boldly scrambling up Independence

Monument, the largest feature in the park, to raise the American flag atop the summit.

John Otto became the first park custodian at Colorado National Monument, earning \$1 a month.

After 16 years he retired and moved to Yreka, California where he died on June 19th, 1952 at age 81 years old. He was buried in a paupers grave.

Funds were raised and on June 19th, 2002, 50 years later on the anniversary of his death, the Colorado National Monument Association erected a sandstone headstone in the shape of the Independence Monument, to honor the hero of this story, John Otto, a man with a monumental vision.


